

## Volunteer Position Description

Dinner Service Volunteers
Dinner Service volunteers are responsible for serving supper to guests at the Emergency Family Shelter.
Volunteers are responsible for:
<ul> <li>Dining room preparation</li> <li>Serving supper to guests</li> <li>Kitchen and dining room clean-up</li> </ul>
5:00 pm to 6:30 pm (nightly)
This opportunity is available to groups of 2-4 volunteers. Youth who are at least 8 years old are welcome provided a youth waiver is signed. For youth 8-11 years of age we ask for a 1:1 child to adult ratio and for 12+ a 3:1 ratio. Dinner Service volunteers are:
<ul> <li>Reliable and punctual</li> <li>Courteous and personable</li> <li>Self-starters, comfortable taking initiative</li> <li>Team spirited and cooperative</li> <li>Comfortable working with a diverse and marginalized population</li> <li>Respectful of guest privacy and confidentiality</li> <li>Dishwasher can only be operated by volunteers 15 and older. Dishes are very hot after coming out of the dishwasher; Please exercise caution when handling freshly-washed dishes.</li> </ul>
Orientation and training will be provided by Inn from the Cold's Volunteer Resource and/or Kitchen Teams.
Dinner Service volunteers report to the Coordinator, Volunteer Resources, With on-site supervision from the Kitchen team.
